

AUTHORIZATION FOR DIAGNOSTIC OCULAR HEALTH TESTS

We routinely perform the following tests during the course of the examination process. However, since your insurance company will NOT cover them, you have the option of having them performed (as an out-of-pocket expense).

These “Wellness Tests” are important in developing a baseline of your eye health, as well as, identifying a timely follow-up strategy to track eye changes, issues or disease.

1. Optomap Retinal Examination - \$45.00

This test photographs the back of your eye looking for retinal detachments, macular degeneration and other health problems. Dilating your eye may not be necessary after this test and your eyes won't be blurred the rest of the day.

2. OCT Scan - \$30.00

The Optical Coherence Tomography test measures the thickness of the nerve fiber layer & aids in early glaucoma and retinal disease detection.

3. Maia Screening - \$30.00 Patients 40 years and older: This test checks for macula sensitivity and aids in the evaluation of macular degeneration.

Corneal Topography Screening: \$25.00

It displays a map of the cornea which aids in proper contact lens fitting and monitoring corneal health. This test is also required for patients who have had Corneal Refractive Surgery.

Contact Lens Evaluation:

Your comprehensive exam does not include an evaluation of contact lenses. The contact lens evaluation, \$45.00, allows us to evaluate your lenses using the slit lamp, verify & update the lens fit, check your vision with your lenses, determine if any issues have arisen & discuss alternative prescriptions if necessary. The Contact Lens Evaluation is \$99.00 for Medicare pts., and Optima or Tricare-Standard K-cone pts, co-pays apply when applicable. If your diagnosis is Keratoconus or you've had a transplant and your vision plan is Davis Vision, VSP or Eyemed your contact lens evaluation is \$75.00.
